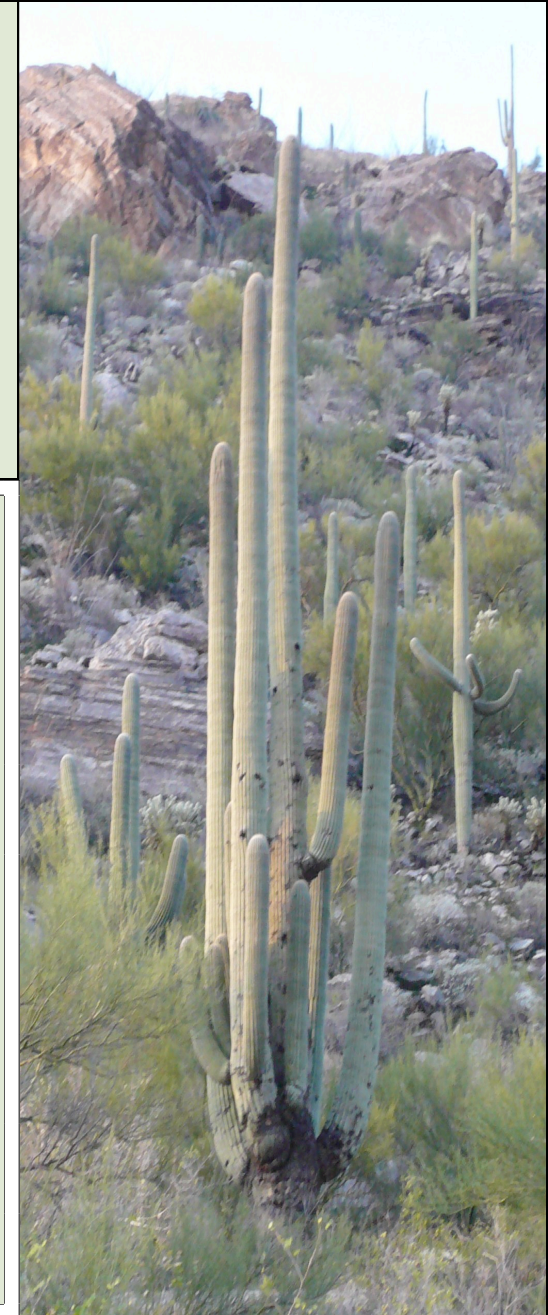

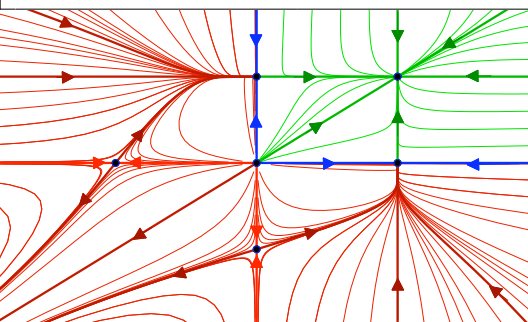


Program: Participating students will experience a taste of what life is like for a research mathematician. They will: work in groups on projects, interact with senior mathematicians, present results in a mini-conference, possibly publish a paper, and interact with undergraduates from around the country.

Topics of Research: Research will be in the general areas of geometry and differential equations. Some projects will be related to discrete geometry and others will be related to geometries on Lie groups. We expect projects will have both an experimental and a theoretical component.

Support: \$1600 + travel and accommodations.
