

Math120R: WebAssign Information:

First time registration/log-in:

- 1.) Go to <https://www.webassign.net/login.html> and click on "I have a class key".
- 2.) Enter in our section's class key.
- 3.) Verify the course information and click the appropriate button.
- 4.) Fill out form to create your WA account. You may choose any available username but make it easy to remember! I would suggest your UANetID.
- 5.) Finally, you will be prompted to either enter in an access code from a new text booklet (shrink-wrapped with your book) , purchase an access code (for \$35-60 depending on what features you choose to access), or proceed for a trial 24 day period. It will remind you each time they log in to provide an access code if you proceed with the trial.

For subsequent log-ins, simply enter your user id, school (arizona), and password at <https://www.webassign.net/login.html>. DO NOT GO THROUGH STEPS 1-5 MORE THAN ONCE! If you lose your log-in information, contact WebAssign for your log-in.

Some comments:

- * Pay attention to the variable.
- * After two attempts, stop and redo the problem.
- * Don't enter an equivalent expression when your attempt is marked wrong.
- * Leaving out parentheses is not just a careless mistake.
- * SIMPLIFY, even if not required to do so on WebAssign.
- * Trial and error is not an efficient way to answer a problem with a small number of attempts allowed.
- * Keep neat records of your scratchwork!
- * Not reading the problem carefully has consequences.
- * If you are doing your online homework properly, they will help prepare you for written homework, quizzes, and exams.
