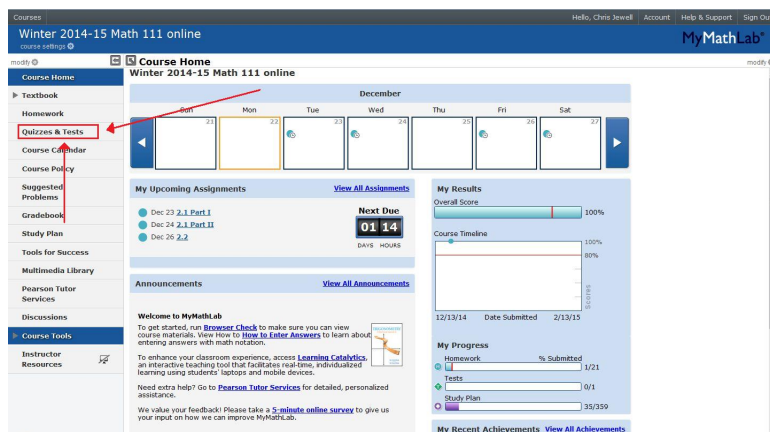
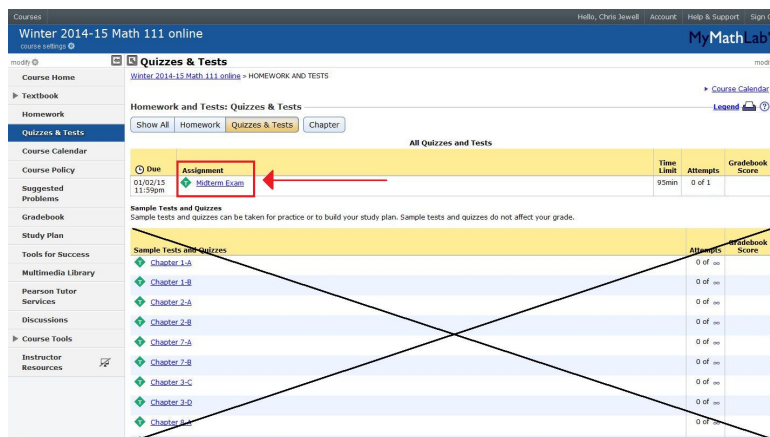


University of Arizona Math 111 Summer Session Exam Notes (ProctorU)

- Before beginning the exam, students should have only pencils, clean scratch paper, and a calculator in front of them. The only browser window/tab that should be open is the one which they will use for the exam (and obviously any necessary for successful proctoring of the exam).
- Students will take the exam through MyMathLab (www.mymathlab.com). They will sign in through MyMathLab (just as they have done for all other aspects of the course), then choose the “Quizzes & Tests” tab in the toolbar on the left-hand side of the page.



- There will be an item available near the top of the page clearly labeled as the exam. NOTE: there will be two sections of items available. The exam will be in the top section, ***not*** in the lower “Sample Tests and Quizzes” portion.



- Upon clicking on the name of the exam, students/proctors will be prompted for the exam password.
- Once “I am ready to start” is clicked, the time limit for the exam will begin.
- The time remaining for the exam is clearly visible in the toolbar at the top of each question. Note that there is an additional 5 minutes given above the stated time of the exam, to allow time for small unforeseen technical issues.
- If students are using a different computer than they have been using for other portions of the course, they may need to install the appropriate version of Flash Player.
