

WebAssign Instructions

There will be regular assignments to be completed using the online tool WebAssign. Completing these assignments properly will help prepare you for the quizzes, tests, and final exam.

Registration

To register for WebAssign, you will need the access code that came with your new Calculus textbook. If you did not purchase a new textbook this semester, you may purchase an access code at webassign.net.

1. Go to <https://www.webassign.net/login.html> and click on "I have a class key".
2. Enter the class key **arizona 7775 0916**.
3. Verify the course information and click the appropriate button.
4. Fill out the form to create your WebAssign account. When choosing your username, pick something easy to remember, such as your UANetID.
5. Finally, you will be prompted to either enter in your access code from a new text booklet, purchase an access code, or proceed for a trial 5 day period. It will remind you each time you log in to provide an access code if you proceed with the trial.

For subsequent log-ins, simply enter in your username, school (**arizona**), and password at <https://www.webassign.net/login.html>.

Remarks

- Spend the time to read the problem carefully.
- You have five attempts at each problem. After two attempts, stop and redo the problem. Trial and error is not an efficient way to answer a problem with a small number of attempts allowed.
- Use the preview feature, and be careful for mistakes such as missing parentheses.
- Don't enter an equivalent expression when your attempt is marked wrong.
- Pay attention to the variable. You will need to enter the same appropriate variable in the problem statement in your answer to be recognized as correct.
- Simplify, even if not required to do so on WebAssign.
- Keep neat records of your scratchwork. This will help to find an error if you need to.
