

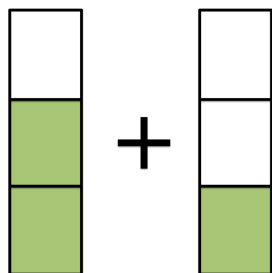

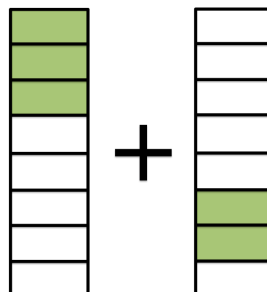
If a candy bar is divided into 4 equal pieces and 3 pieces are given away, what **fraction** of the candy bar remains?
