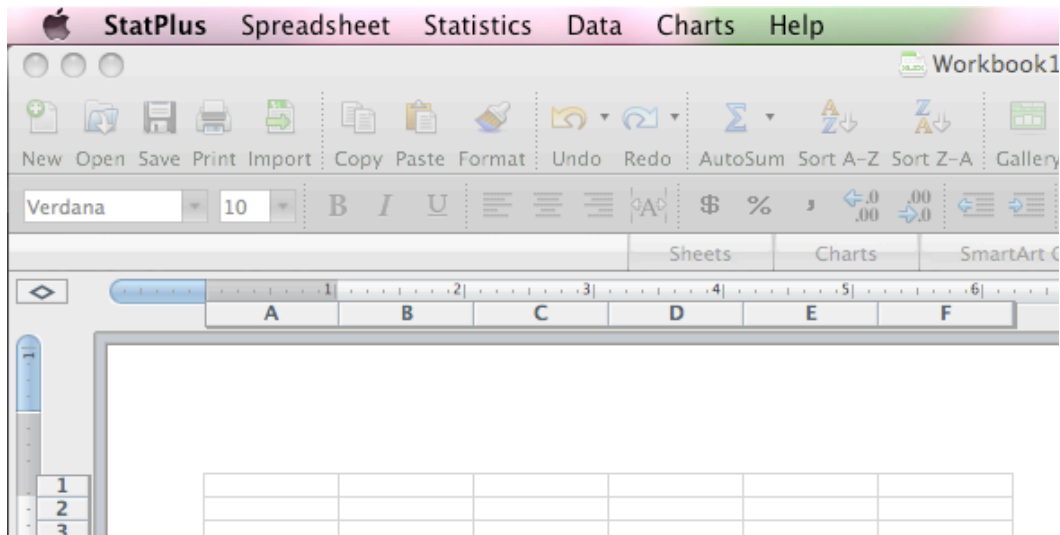


Getting Started on Excel 2008 for Mac

- With Excel 2008, it is necessary to download and install a “sister program” called StatPlus, which can be found here:

- StatPlus also has a version that costs \$200, but the free version will do everything you need. It acts sort of like the Analysis Toolpack.
- It is important to note that StatPlus “controls” Excel. If you open StatPlus, it will automatically open Excel. The best idea is to drag the program into your dock (the string of programs at the bottom or side of your screen) and place it right next to Excel, like this:



- When doing the homework, be sure to have StatPlus open with Excel. It should look like this:



- Finally, the menu ribbons on Excel for Mac are much simpler than they are on a PC:
