

Homework Policy
Math120 - 001: Calculus Preparation
Fall 2012

- Non-examination assessment will consist of electronic homework, written homework and unannounced quizzes. They are weighed approximately 40%, 40% and 20% respectively of the final non-examination assessment grade. Quizzes will generally be held in the middle of the class period.
- Announcements will be made regularly online via email or the course website. (see below)
- The class key for the electronic component of homework (WebAssign) is **arizona 0233 7766**.
- There will be no make ups for in class quizzes. If you are absent for a quiz, a zero score will be given for that quiz.
- Electronic and written homework, as well as their due dates, will be announced in class/online on a weekly basis.
- Written homework should be handed in at the start of class. If you arrive late but within the first 10 minutes of class, you must hand in the homework as soon as you enter the class room. Any homework handed in later than the first 10 minutes of class will be considered late and will not be accepted. Several of the lowest homework grades will be dropped at the end of the semester.
- Make up homework will be given upon discretion of the instructor. In case of an excused absence (medical reasons, dean's excuse, etc.), please notify the instructor in advance for full-credit make up work.
- Show your work! Credit may not be given for correct answers without relevant work.
- No credit will be given for illegible work.
- Homework should have name, date, course and section number, and assignment title.
- Handwriting must be neat and legible.
- Homework must be on letter-sized paper (white or lined).
- If multiple pages are handed in, they must be stapled.
- No fringes/fuzzy edges.
